#### Professor Emeritus Tan Sri Datuk Dr Hj Omar bin Abdul Rahman Member, UCSI University Council

Tan Sri Omar is a Malaysian academician and corporate figure. He was honoured with Emeritus Professor title by Universiti Putra Malaysia. A path-breaking thinker, in 1984, Tan Sri Dr Omar was appointed as a science advisor to the Prime Minister, the first Malaysian to hold the esteemed position. In 2010, he was given the distinction of Tokoh Akademik Negara ke-10 in recognition of his immense achievements in the academic arena. He is one of the prime movers of the International Smart Partnership Dialogues regularly held in Langkawi, Malaysia (LID), and in Southern Africa (SAID), which promote the ethos and practice of Smart Partnership, the win-win philosophy for all forms of cooperative undertaking and multi-stakeholder partnering. He is also in the Organising Committee for the 'Dialog Rakyat for National Cohesion and Unity'.



#### Dr Hakim Young International Coordinator, Afghan Peace Volunteers

Since 2002, Dr Hakim, a medical physician trained in Singapore, has worked among Afghans in Pakistan and Afghanistan as a medical humanitarian worker, a community and livelihood development facilitator, and a peace-builder. Prior to his work abroad, he volunteered many times with the Singapore Anti-Narcotics Association and Teen Challenge, and with Tetraplegia Workgroup Singapore. He is the 2012 recipient of the International Pfeffer Peace Prize by the Fellowship of Reconciliation (USA) for his work with the Afghan Peace Volunteers and the 2017 recipient of the Singapore Medical Association Merit Award for contributions in social service to communities.

Professor Datuk Dr Denison Jayasooria is Honorary Professor at the Institute of Ethnic Studies (KITA) Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM). He is the Head of the All Party Parliamentary Group Malaysia on Sustainable Development Goals. (APPGM-SDG)

He holds a PhD in Sociology from Oxford Brookes University, United Kingdom. He was recently appointed by the Prime Minister as a member of the National Action Council for Shared Prosperity Vision 2030. He has been a member of the National Unity Advisory Council, Ministry of Nation Unity since 2020. He is also a member of the National SDG Steering Committee established by the Economic Planning Unit in 2016.
